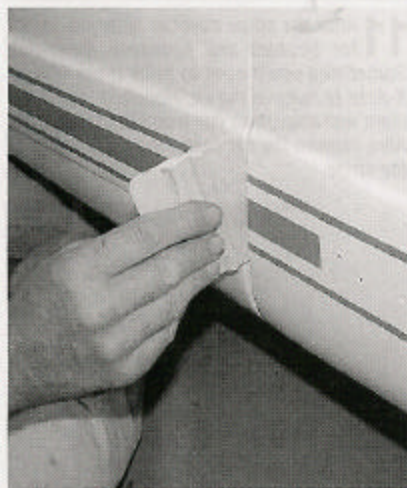

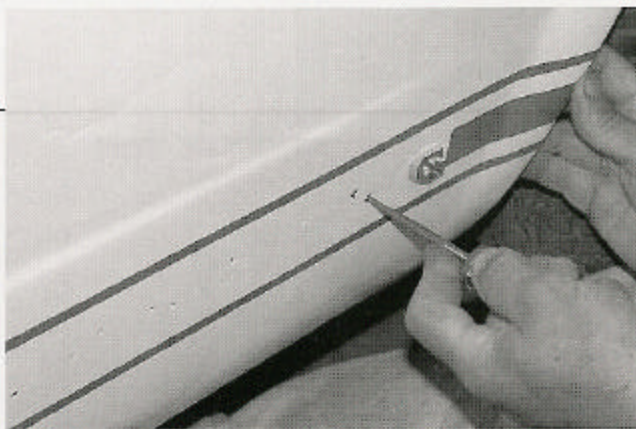
Stripe Your '65-'66 GT



13 On the door stripe and the rear-quarter stripe, leave the stripe taped to the area and remove the backing paper after a liberal spray of soapy water. Always pull the stripe back over itself as shown.



14 Use the squeegee to slip the excess stripe inside the door edge. These will be folded over after the striping of this side is complete.



15 As for the letters, use an awl to clean the holes of excess paint, then use the same tool to apply the barrel clips for the letters. Of course, we're using new letters since the car is a fresh resto.



16 If the barrel clips are a bit frisky and not inclined to go in, use the butt of the awl to persuade them. The plastic handle is less likely than other persuaders to mar a finish.



17 So now you know how to apply stripes to your original GT fenders. Our thanks go out to Classic Creations and Dallas Mustang for all their help.
